L. 92-463, as amended by Pub. L. 94-409, and as cited in 5 U.S.C. 552b(c)(6).

The agenda for November 18 will begin with an update on recent events, followed by responses from Committee members. The first day's agenda will also cover reports on activities of the Persian Gulf Spouses and Children Exam, Persian Gulf Programs/Surveys, and Veterans Benefits Applications from Persian Gulf Veterans, as well as a follow-up on VA Referral Centers.

On November 19 the Committee will hear reports on the Syntax of Immune-Neuroendocrine Communications/PTSD as well as an updates on Research Centers findings and DoD Investigative Team Operations.
