SUMMARY: The United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, has filed an application to withdraw 74,380.50 acres of National Forest System lands and 320 acres of non-Federal lands, if acquired, for protection of the San Francisco Peaks/Mount Elden Recreation Area. This notice closes the lands for up to 2 years from location and entry under the United States mining laws. The lands will remain open to all other uses which may be made of National Forest System lands. The non-Federal lands would also be closed to mining by this notice if acquired by the United States during the 2-year period.

The proposed information collection is published to obtain comments from the public and affected agencies.
