	The functions of the President under the heading "Iraq Relief and Reconstruc- tion Fund" in the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2003 (Public Law 108–11), including with respect to apportionment, reim- bursement, consultation, transfer of funds, retransfer of funds, and acceptance and crediting of contributions, are assigned to the Director of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).
	In accordance with Presidential direction relating to Iraq relief and recon- struction, multiple agencies are deployed with the Office of Reconstruction and Humanitarian Assistance (ORHA) and are serving as implementing part- ners or executing agents for programs and projects. These agencies will identify funding requirements for such programs and projects through ORHA. OMB will work with ORHA to transfer funds to the appropriate implementing agency. The Director of OMB shall coordinate with the Secretary of Defense or his designee prior to apportioning funds. With respect to programs admin- istered by the Department of State or the United States Agency for Inter- national Development, the Director of OMB shall coordinate with the Sec- retary of State or his designee prior to apportioning funds.
