*Abstract:* In December 2014, OMB together with NASA and the other Federal awarding agencies, issued a joint interim rule to implement the new

guidance at 2 CFR 200 titled “Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (Uniform Guidance).” OMB used the rulemaking procedure when promulgating this common rule on grants and cooperative agreements and required each agency to adopt OMB’s common rule on grants and cooperative agreements These revisions fulfill OMB guidance.
